PWNA provides immediate relief to Native American communities through goods and services delivered year round for nutrition, health, education, animal welfare and emergency relief. PWNA also supports long-term solutions such as scholarships, training for grassroots leaders and community investment projects to help end the cycle of poverty.

Taking place on Dec. 1, #GivingTuesday is held annually on the first Tuesday following Thanksgiving, Black Friday, and Cyber Monday to kick-off the holiday giving season. The day

is designed to inspire people to collaborate on improving their local communities and to give back in impactful ways to those charities and causes they support.

Donations for the Newman's Own Foundation Challenge will be hosted on CrowdRise, an online crowd fundraising platform for nonprofits. PWNA is one of 24 organizations selected to participate this year by Newman's Own Foundation, the independent foundation created by late actor and philanthropist, Paul Newman.
